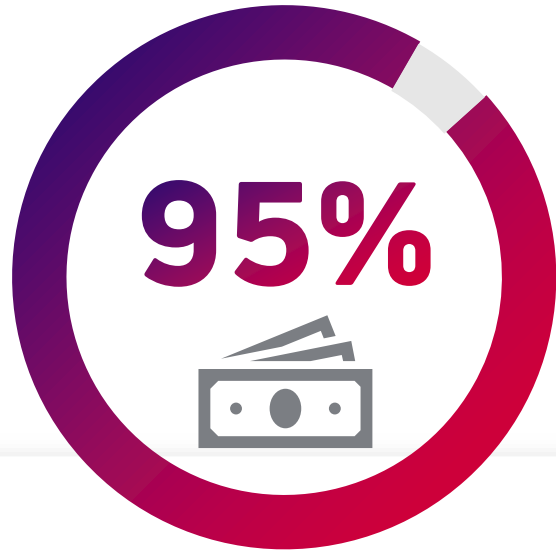

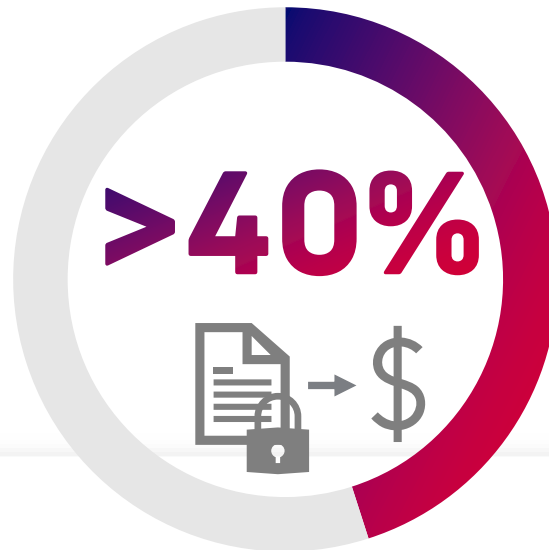

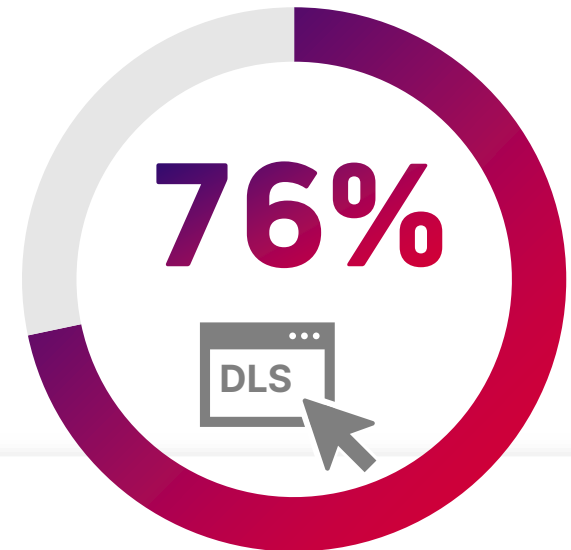
Recent Facts on Data Leakage

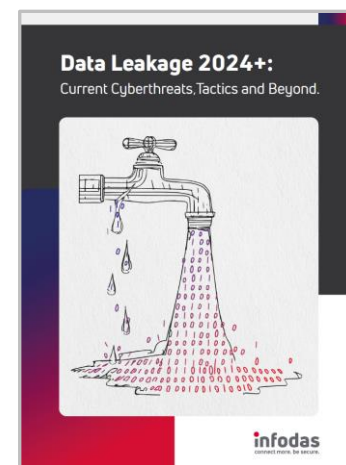
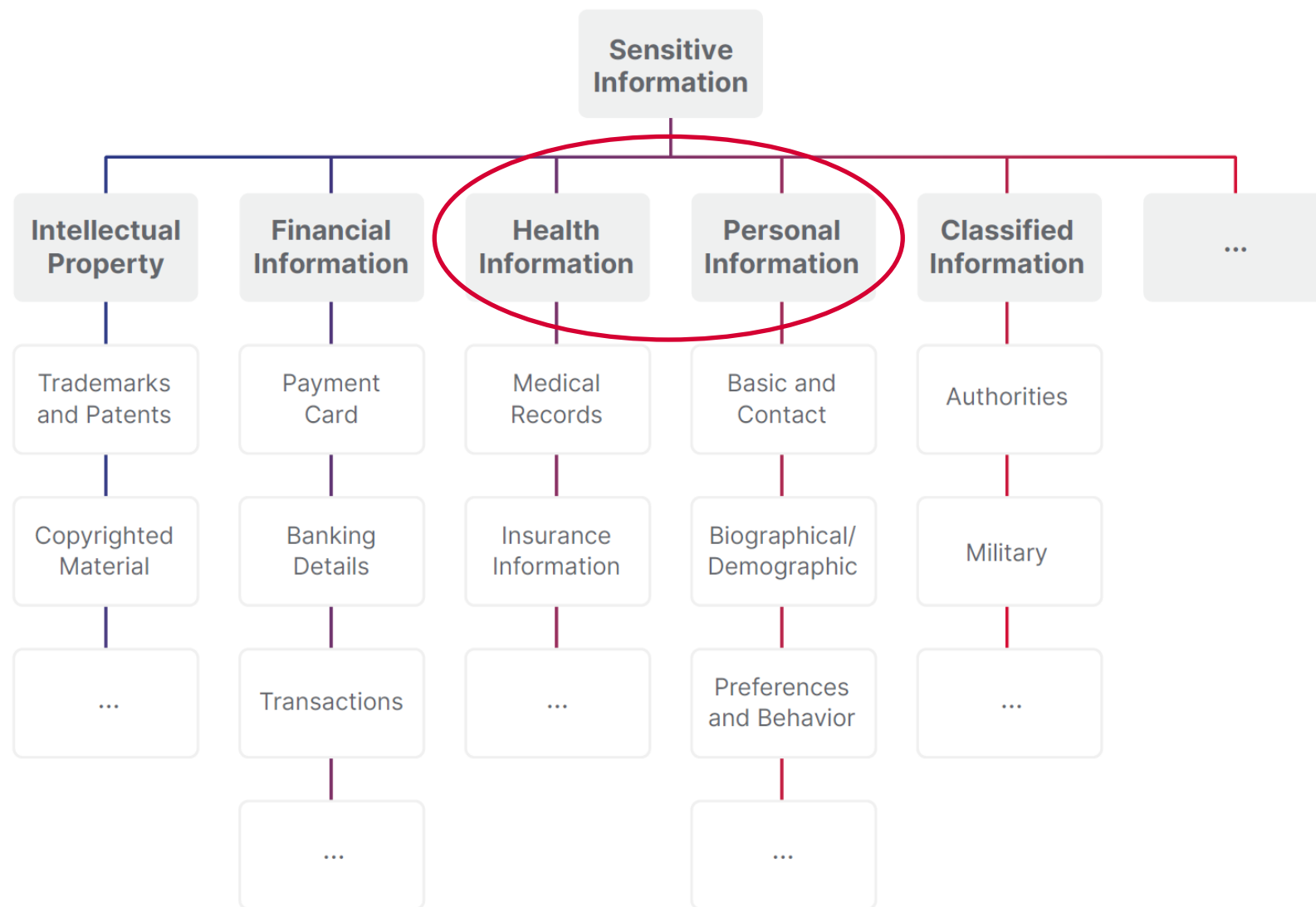
Data Leakage Trends Exemplified by Data Extortion

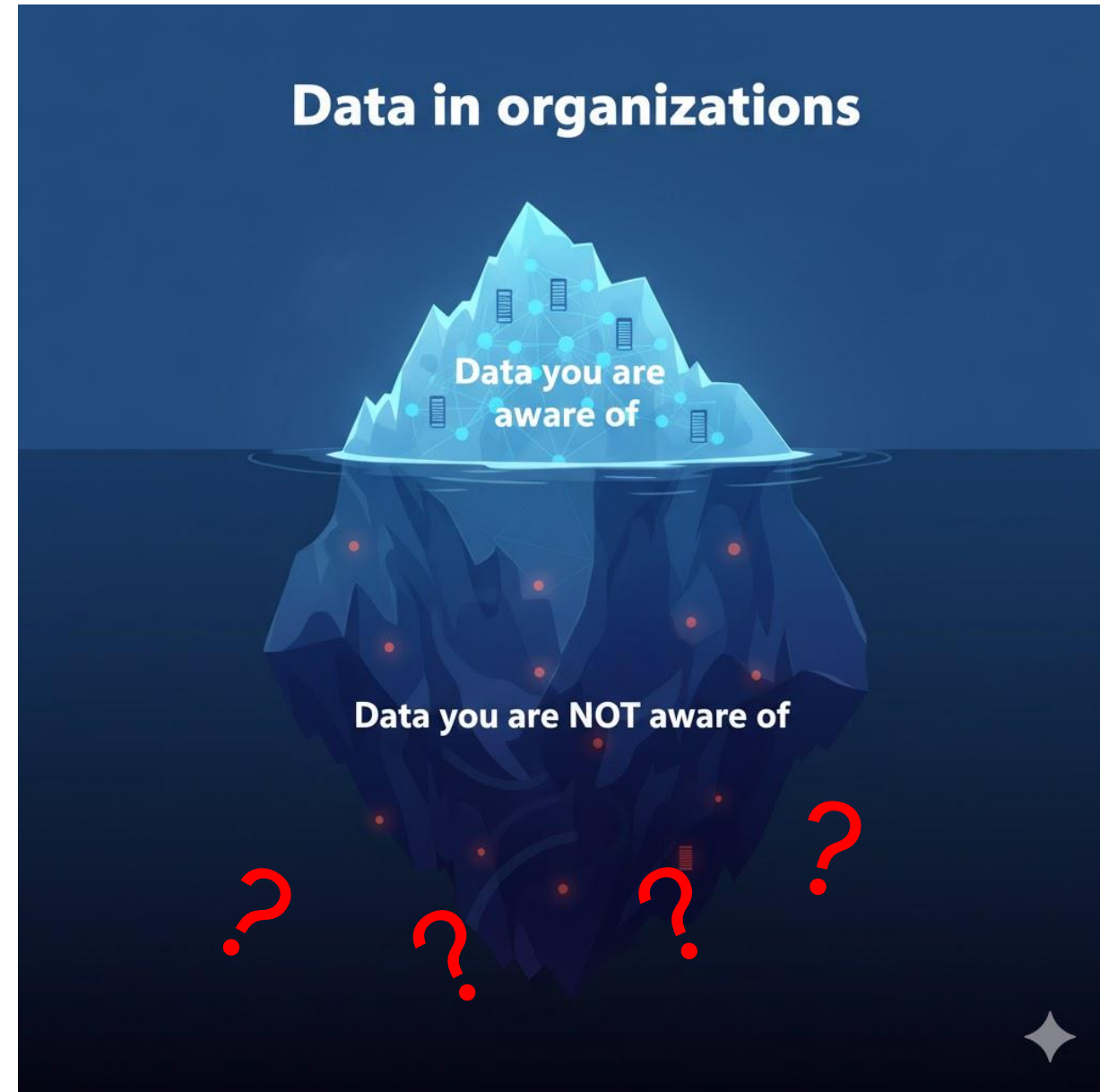

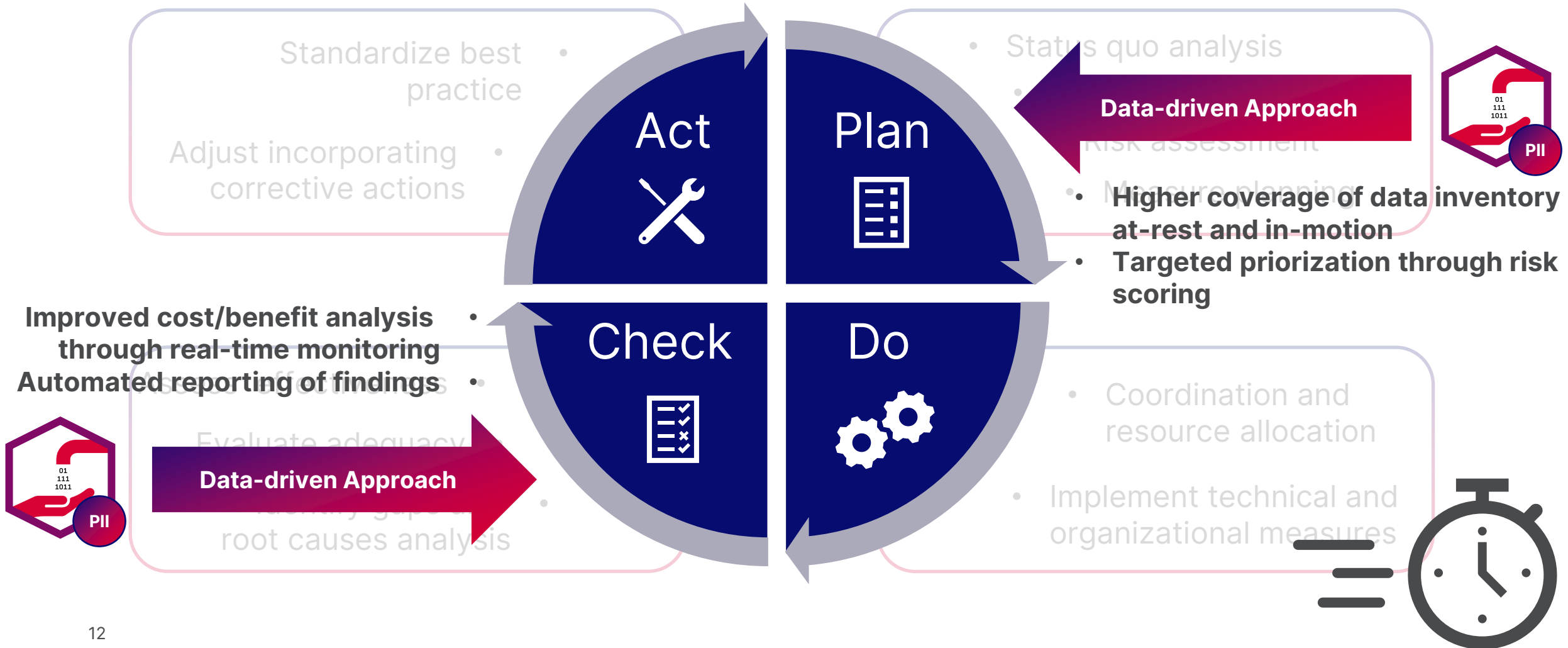
